

ADDENDUM TO SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT CITY OF SUMTER IP-20-4301-03

This Addendum to the Subrecipient Agreement (the "Agreement") is made and entered into on February 8, 2023, nunc pro tunc, by and between the South Carolina Office of Resilience ("SCOR"); referred to as the "grantee" and the City of Sumter; referred to as the "awardee." The SC Office of Resilience and the City of Sumter shall herein collectively be referred to as the "parties" and generically as a "party".
