1.0 PROJECT INFORMATION

Our Scope of Services is based on our understanding of the project as described by information provided by Pam Kindrick with South Carolina Office of Resilience.

Location	Intersection of US-17 (Ocean Highway) and McKissick Drive, Pawleys Island, SC
Description	The project consists of approximately 151 LF of twin 30" reinforced concrete pipes jack and bored under US Hwy 17, approximately 483 LF of 48" reinforced concrete pipe running from Mingo pond and parallel with US Hwy 17 South with associated catch basins and junction boxes, a new outfall headwall, a new outlet structure in Mingo Pond, and a section of 8' wide bike path to be removed and replaced. There will also be approximately 700 SF of asphalt replaced along US Hwy 17.

2.0 SCOPE OF SERVICES

Material Testing and Special Inspection Services

The requested inspection and testing services requested for this project will be conducted by Terracon in accordance with the recommendations and requirements offered by the project contract documents, the SCDT Specifications, and the applicable ASTM testing and material standards, as well as other applicable referenced standards.

We understand our scope of services for this project will include observations and/or testing of the following areas of construction:

SWPPP / NPDES Inspections

2.1 SWPPP / NPDES Inspections

Terracon will conduct weekly Certified Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control Inspections (CEPSCI) to assure that the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) is being followed and that Best Management Practices are in place, as part of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) requirements. These inspections would be conducted by a Certified Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control Inspector. Storm water inspection reports would be generated during each inspection as required by the Construction General Permit (CGP). During the inspection, the inspector will identify any deficiencies noted and recommend appropriate actions to address each deficiency.

3.0 **TERMS**

3.1 Compensation

Based on our review of the project drawings and the specifications, Terracon has estimated the following budgets to provide material testing, special inspection, and engineering services as detailed in this proposal. A detailed budget estimate for Terracon's services for this project is attached. Based upon our experience with other similar local projects, we estimate the following cost for our services.

3.2 Assumptions

If you believe we need to increase or decrease our scope of services / trip frequency, please notify us so we can make the appropriate changes. Our fees include all anticipated charges for mileage, travel, equipment, personnel, etc. for the anticipated scope of services. Terracon will provide you with monthly invoices for approval of payment.

3.3 Exclusions

Unless arrangements are made to perform the work in a different manner, the responsibility of our field personnel will consist of making observations, performing tests, and then reporting their findings to an authorized person such as the site superintendent for appropriate action. If substandard work is being performed or if materials of inferior quality are being used, it will be the responsibility of your authorized person to have these conditions corrected. Should it be possible to correct such conditions amicably on the basis of oral recommendations by our technician, it can be done in this manner. However, if it becomes necessary to reject material or to discontinue the work, we expect that someone other than our personnel make such decisions.

Client shall secure all necessary site related approvals, permits, licenses, and consents necessary to commence and complete the Services and will execute any necessary site access agreement. Consultant will be responsible for supervision and site safety measures for its own employees but shall not be responsible for the supervision or health and safety precautions for any third parties, including Client's contractors, subcontractors, or other parties present at the site. In addition, Consultant retains the right to stop work without penalty at any time Consultant believes it is in the best interests of Consultant's employees or subcontractors to do so in order
