## Still have repairs or other disaster-caused needs?

The South Carolina Office of Resilience is administering a \$150M Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery program, a federal grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The public is invited to provide input on the Action Plan, which outlines how this funding will be spent, and apply to SCOR for housing and other disaster recovery assistance. Additionally, SCOR intends to spend all allocated funds to benefit low- and moderate-income residents.



- The rehabilitation, replacement, or reconstruction of single-family homes.
- Rehabilitation of affordable rental housing.
- Voluntary buyouts of houses in the floodplain or those that have been repetitively flooded.



Programs to reduce the impacts of future disasters:

- Infrastructure
- Voluntary Buyouts
- Plans & Studies
- Matching funds for other federal mitigation grants

## Who is eligible?

Low to moderate income <u>homeowners</u>, and <u>rental</u> <u>property owners</u> in the following counties can apply directly with SCOR for housing recovery: Abbeville, Aiken\*, Anderson\*, Cherokee, Edgefield, Greenville\*, Greenwood\*, Laurens\*, McCormick, Oconee, Orangeburg, Pickens, Saluda, Spartanburg\*, Union.

\*80% of CDBG-DR funds must be spent in these counties

<u>Cities, towns, counties, councils of government, and state agencies</u> in the following "most impacted and distressed" counties may apply for mitigation funds:

Aiken, Anderson, Greenville, Greenwood, Laurens,

Spartanburg.

Eligible residents of other counties declared by FEMA for individual assistance, and The Catawba Nation, who are not eligible for CDBG-DR activities may be eligible for a state funded rebuild program for destroyed homes or assistance by non-profit or volunteer organizations for damaged homes. These are: Allendale, Bamberg, Barnwell, Beaufort, Chester, Fairfield, Hampton, Jasper, Kershaw, Lexington, Newberry, Richland, and York.
